

Standard Trim Sizes by Genre

Trim size refers to the final dimensions of a book after it's printed and cut. Choosing the right trim size is crucial for aesthetics, readability, and marketability.

Fiction & Nonfiction

- **Mass Market Paperback:** 4.25" x 6.87"
- **Trade Paperback:** 5" x 8", 5.25" x 8", 5.5" x 8.5", 6" x 9"
- **Hardcover:** 6" x 9" to 8.5" x 11"

These sizes are standard for most fiction and nonfiction books, including genres like romance, mystery, and memoirs.

Children's Books

- **Picture Books:** 8" x 8", 8.5" x 8.5", 10" x 8", 11" x 8.5"
- **Chapter Books:** 5" x 8", 5.25" x 8"

Children's books often have larger trim sizes to accommodate illustrations and larger text.

Art & Photography Books

- **Common Sizes:** 10" x 8", 11" x 8.5", 12" x 12", 13" x 11"
